

How To Edit Skins

The Easy Way

The super simple way to create a new look skin is to replace the .jpg files found in a skin folder with your own .jpg files. Too easy!!

For example;

Find a skin you like, don't look at the picture, just the text color, info offered and layout. Connect to your Xbox via your PC and open your FTP client.

Navigate your way to the skin folder you chose and open it. Inside you will see one or two .jpg files. Let's say, for example, they were called apicture.jpg and bpicture.jpg. Delete these files and find the pictures you want to use instead. Re-name these pictures you want to use to apicture.jpg and bpicture.jpg and copy them over to the skin directory you deleted the others out of.

That's it!!

If you want to get a bit tricky, you could edit the .ini file found in the same directory. This file can be edited with the notepad we supplied on the Xbox or with the windows version. The .ini file looks like this;

This is a basic skin. Good one to play with for starters. Copy this txt and save it as skin.ini change the .jpg names first to match the .jpg's you want to use and then make a folder under c:\skin called myskin. Then copy the .jpg and .ini files into c:\skin\myskin.

All done!! Once you have mastered that you can play with the other settings to learn what they do. Other skins allow you to also change the text content like IP address, HDD space, Rom status and more.

If you make a cool skin you think is worth handing out, zip it up and send it to us and we may put it on our skins page for all to download and use.
